# Overall Results of Assessment Survey Spring 2013

#### **ADVANCED LEVEL I:**

- 47 out of 58 students responded from 3 classes.
- Responses to question 1 were multiple and more than 50% of the students marked Personal Growth and Job / Career related as a priority.
   Furthering one's education ran a close second.
- Responses to Question 2 indicate that approximately 75% of the students met their personal goal. 22% feel they need more class time but made progress.
- 44% of the students polled will be enrolling in the next level. 25% wish to re-enroll but are unable to do so due to a number of issues.(i.e. money or job/ time issues, returning to their country. 22% are undecided.

#### **ADVANCED LEVEL II:**

- 37 out of 64 students from 3 classes responded.
- Responses to question 1 were multiple and the top three answers were Personal Growth, Social Interaction and Job/career related.
- Responses to Question 2 showed that approximately 66% of the students felt they met their goal in the classes. 33% felt they needed more time.
- Only one student was disappointed with the class.
- Responses to Question 3 indicate that 62% of the students will enroll for the next level.
- 25% of the remaining students will not enroll or are undecided due to personal issues.(i.e. returning to their country, change in work hours, lack of finances.)

#### **CONVERSATION AND WRITING LEVEL I:**

- 21 OF 26 students responded from 2 classes.
- Responses to Question 1 had Personal growth and Job/career related as the top answers.

- Responses to Question 2 indicate that 86% of the students met their goals. 10 % felt they needed more writing.
- 52 % of the students in response to Question 3 will enroll again.
- Of the remaining 48%, there are 25% who must return to their country or who feel they met their personal goal. 15% are undecided due to work issues.

## **CONVERSATION AND WRITING LEVEL II: (Including Civics 407/408)**

- 29 of 41 students completed the survey.
- The top two answers to Question 1 were Personal Growth and Social Interaction.
- Responses to Question 2 indicate that 56% of the students met their goals. 24 % of the remaining students felt they needed more grammar and writing to complete their goal.
- 58% of the students will return for another class. Of the 7 students who are not returning, 2 students are enrolled in a program on the Paramus campus and 4 are returning to their country. 2 more students who are undecided have work/calendar issues.

#### **OVERALL SUMMATION;**

- 134 Students out of a possible 189 were surveyed.
- The top answers for Question 1 were Personal Growth and Job/Career related with Social Interaction a close third.
- More than 50% of the student polled felt they met their goals.
- 54% of the student will enroll again for another level.
- 25 % of the students who said they will not enroll will not do so because of personal issues. (Work, Money, Returning to their country, etc.
- 12% of the students polled were still undecided about returning.
