After reviewing the results, what analyses can be derived?	
1.	total number of students enrolled in eight sections of online information literacy during spring and summer 2011: 240. Only 38% percent of those enrolled attended the sessions. Course instructors did not require students to attend. However, the two

	courses that offered extra credit had the most students in attendance.
2.	All attendees indicated that this was their first experience learning in this setting.
3.	Review of the Chat windows indicate that students were actively involved in the class and were constantly asking questions and making comments.
4.	Many of their comments expressed deep appreciation for the assistance that they were receiving.
