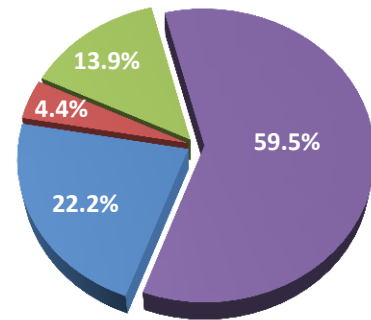

■ First-Time\* ■ Transfer\*\* ■ Stop-out\*\*\* ■ Returning\*\*\*\*

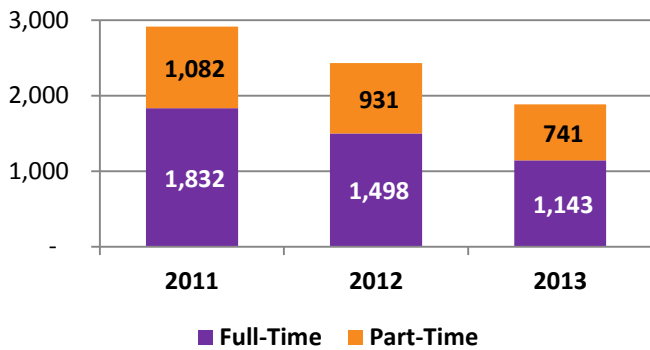

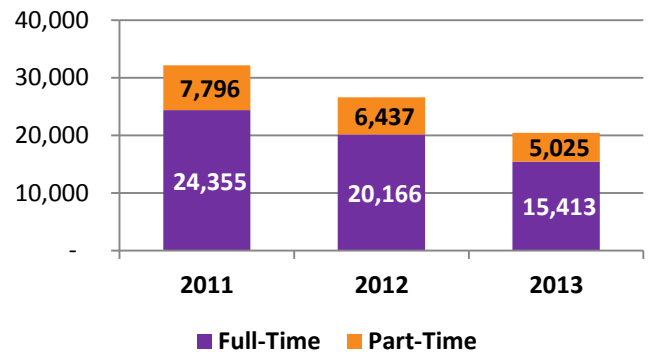

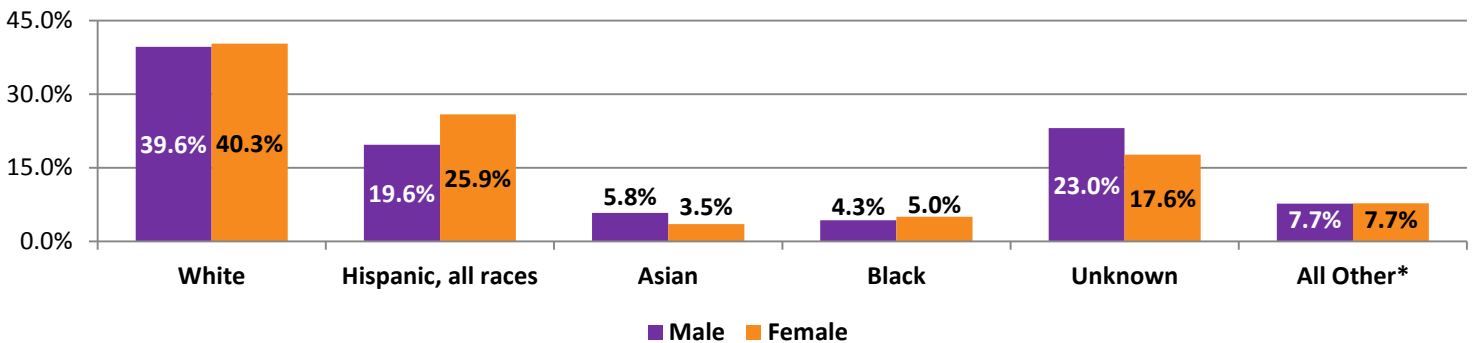

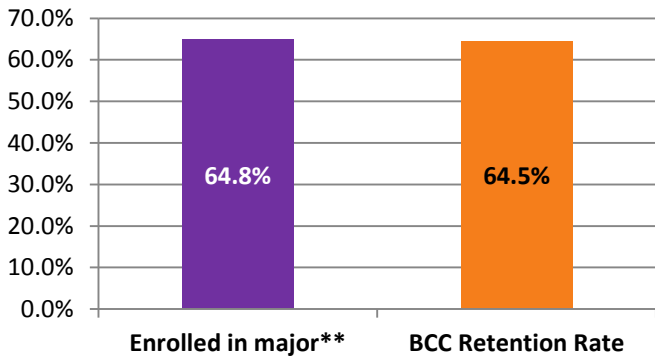
**Enrollment by Gender & Race/Ethnicity, Fall 2013**

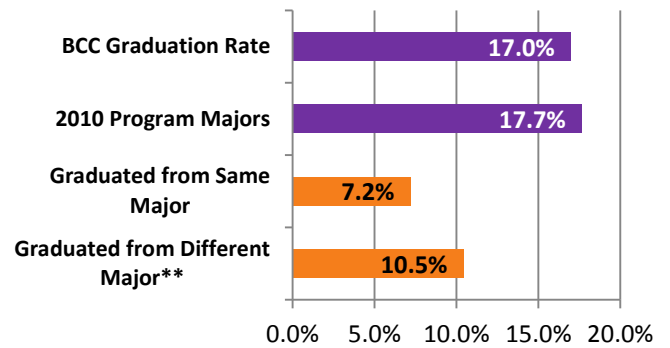
**One-Year Retention, FTFTD\*, Fall 2012**

**Graduation Rates, FTFTD\*, 2010 Cohort**

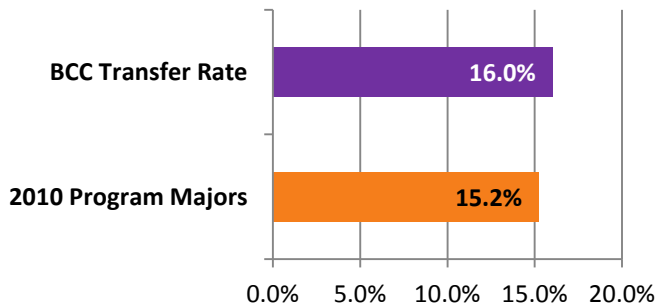

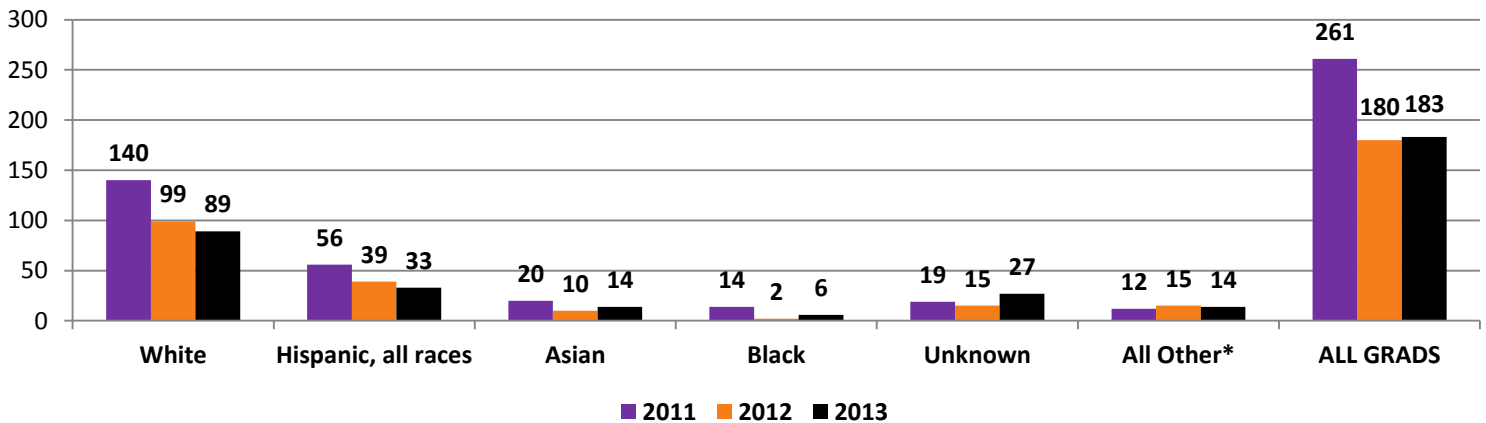
