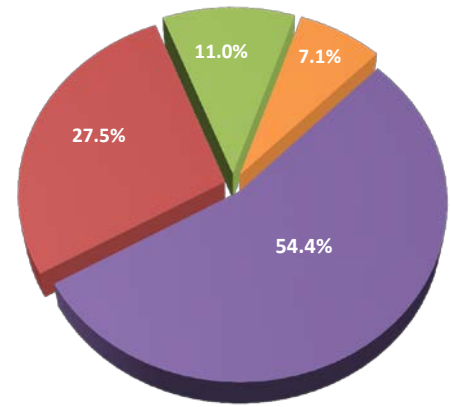

Fall 2012

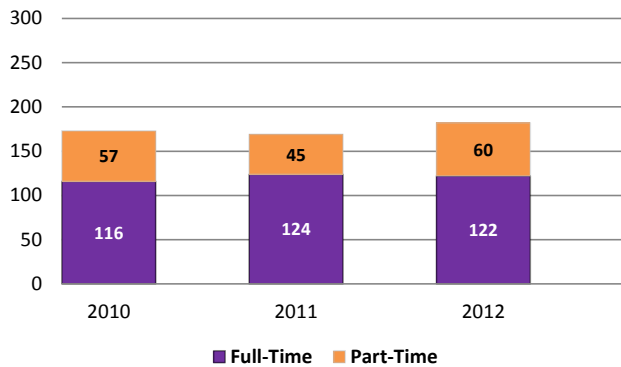

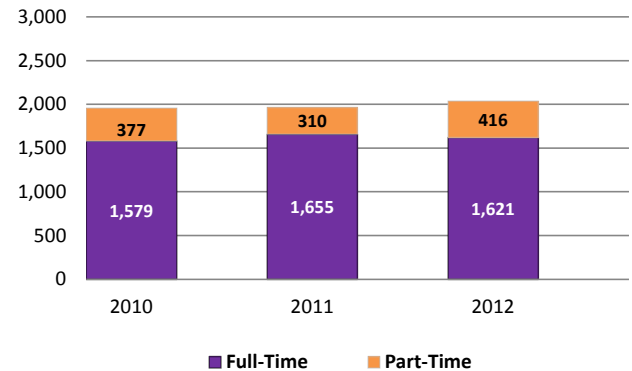

Credits Enrolled by Attendance

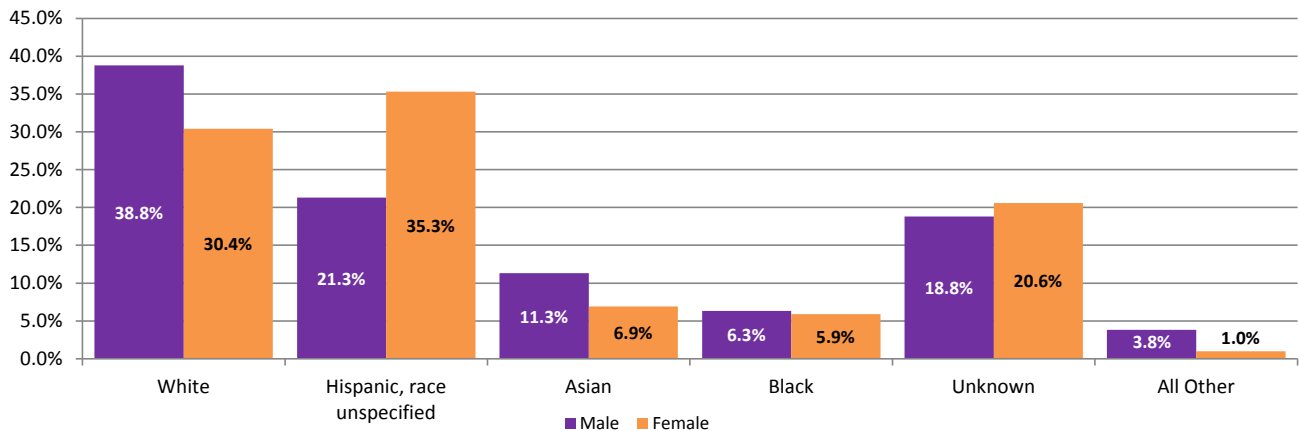

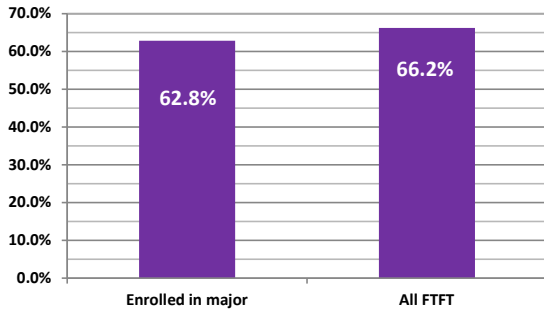

One-Year Retention*, FTFT, Fall 2011



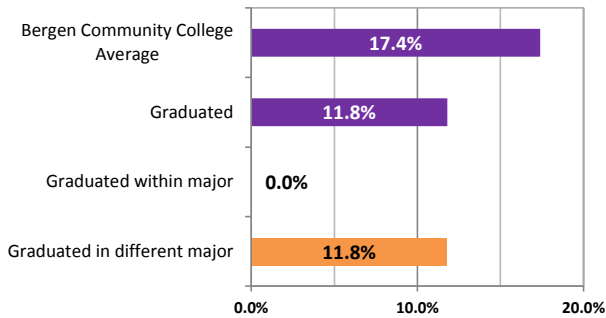

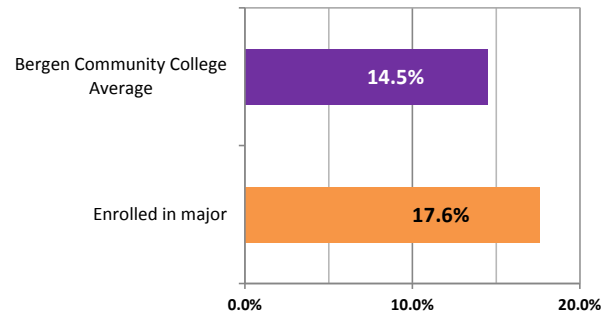

Graduation Rates*, 2009 Cohort



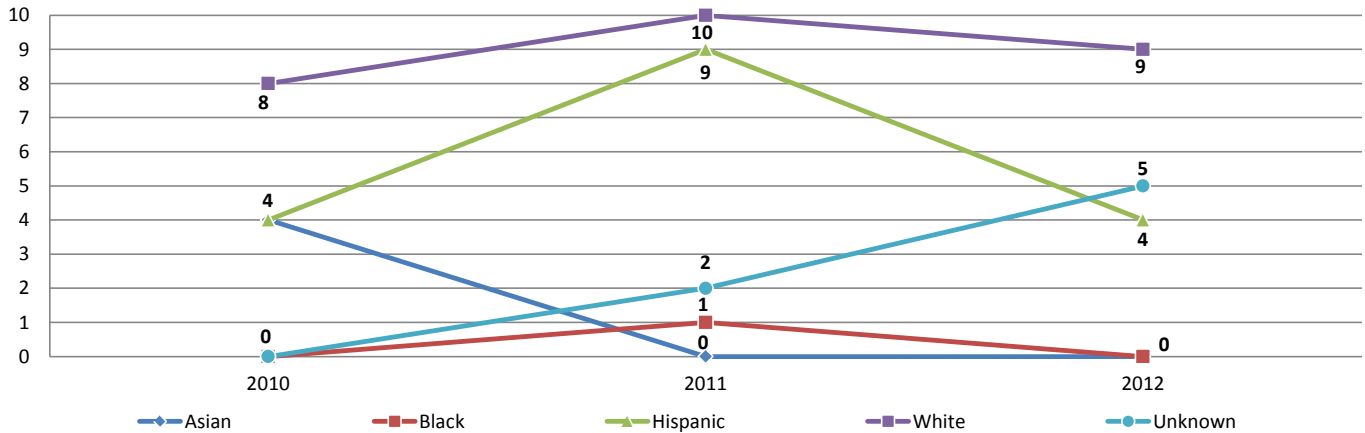
