



NJ STARS Application Process Checklist for New & Transfer Prospective NJ STARS Students

We are excited that as a prospective NJ STARS student, you are eligible to apply to Bergen Community College's NJ STARS program. As a certified NJ STARS student, you will be awarded full tuition for up to five semesters.

IMPORTANT: It is of the utmost importance that all financial aid and HESAA paperwork and information requested is completed by stated deadlines. Compliance will ensure continuous enrollment in Bergen Community College's NJ STARS Program. Failure to complete all documents and provide all requested information may result in an unfunded semester, or possible loss of NJ STARS eligibility.

Financial Aid Review is complete after you review/accept your Financial Aid Award Package in your student portal. If you didn't answer the NJ Additional Application Questions on the FAFSA confirmation page, on the Home Menu, click To Do List, (be sure the correct FAFSA year is displayed) and click the link to answer the questions required to complete the State-based financial aid process. Be sure that the boxes preceding all tasks on the To Do List contain a green checkmark. If not, the task or tasks were either not received or are incomplete.	After completing your FAFSA On the Home Menu of your student portal, click View & Update Your School, then click Add and choose Bergen Community College from the dropdown list if it is not listed. On the Home Menu, click Award & Eligibility Information and scroll down for award status.

As soon after high school graduation as possible but no later than August 31, 2018. • Application/Contract must be fully completed.
NJ STARS Student!	After your NJ STARS Application/Contract has been signed, you will be flagged as an NJ STARS student at Bergen. As long as you bring in your contact to be signed before the semester begins, your classes will be protected until your tuition has been paid by NJ STARS.	Your NJ STARS certification is not official until all federal and state financial aid has been fully reviewed and completed.
