Submit Your Best Paper to the Honors Conference by Friday, March 8, 2019

The Honors Student Conference is a forum for our college students to present their best academic work in a professional conference setting. The conference will have two sessions with multiple concurrent panels in a variety of disciplines, followed by lunch with a keynote speaker. Conference participation is an excellent opportunity for students to present work completed as part of their community college coursework, and is recognized as a significant achievement by four-year colleges. Participating students may be invited to have their papers published in the *Bergen Student Journal*.

You are invited to submit a paper in the following disciplines and subject areas:

The final categories will be determined based on the actual submissions. Readers will select the best papers for inclusion in the program. Papers will be selected based on the following criteria: • Clarity and effectiveness of ideas presented • Originality • Analytical approach • Evidence of research (including proper citations)

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The paper should be typed, double spaced on 8 1/2" x 11" white paper with a margin of 1" all around.
- Pages must be numbered with Arabic numerals in the upper right hand corner.
- The cover sheet should include the student's full name, address, phone number and e-mail. The name of the student must not appear anywhere other than on the title page.
- The paper should be 7-12 pages in length, excluding the bibliography. Presenters will have a total of twenty minutes each to deliver the paper, including a media presentation, if applicable.

ALL current Bergen students are eligible to submit their work, including this year's graduates. After the deadline, students will be promptly notified of the status of their submission.
