

## AMERICAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM (ALP) MESSAGE

You have completed the Bergen Community College **American Language Program** placement test. The results of this test will be used to place you into the appropriate coursework at BCC.

Passing score for **Speech is 91**.

Passing score for the **ALP is 306 total** of Language Usage, Reading Skills and Essay.

Multiply the Essay score by 20 and then add the three test scores together.

**Essay Score times (x) 20 + Language Usage Score + Reading Skills Score = Total**

The highest score on any of the multiple choice tests is 120.

The highest score on the essay is 6.

Refer to your score report for your course placement(s).

You may wish to challenge these results by retaking this examination once at a later date.

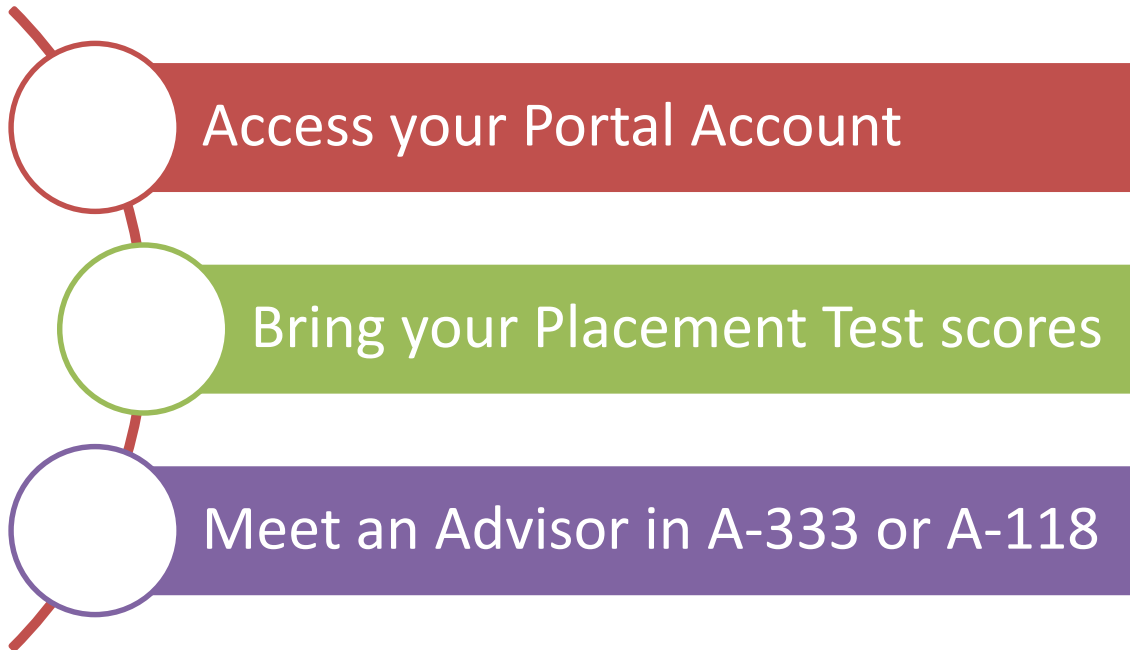
If you are placed into the ALP, you must register for these courses before you are eligible to register for college courses in other subjects.
