ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**Articulation Agreement
2013-2018**

This Articulation Agreement is hereby entered into between **Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Daytona Beach Campus** (hereinafter "ERAU") and **The District Board of Trustees of Bergen Community College** as of the date set forth below.

I. Purpose. This agreement is designed to facilitate the transfer of students from a College (Natural Science or Mathematics – Aircraft Operations Option, Associate of Science) to Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University (Bachelor of Science in Aviation Business Administration) with a minimum loss of credits, if any, and with the greatest of administrative ease. The Articulation Agreement is intended to be used by students who are intending to make the transfer under this program and by the faculty, advisors, counselors and others who might advise these students.

II. Courses and Curriculum. Courses are carefully reviewed and evaluated to insure that their content and course objectives are the equivalent of those at the University. The last page of this agreement, which is incorporated by reference herein, lists the course equivalencies for the 2013-2018 year based on the 2013-2014 catalogs from both Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and Bergen Community College. In the event that either institution's catalog changes with regard to the affected courses or programs, the parties' respective designees shall approve and sign the revised course equivalencies if said designee agrees with all such changes.

Upon acceptance by a student into this program, the student becomes subject to the requirements of the curriculum specified in the catalog at the time of enrollment to assure that the courses taken will still apply even though the curriculum for that major may have undergone a significant change before the student has actually made the transfer to the

University. However, failure to maintain continuous enrollment as defined by the receiving institution's catalog at the time of the student's initial enrollment will void the student's right to utilize the catalog in effect at the time of admission and will require readmission to the program. The ERAU catalog in effect when the student is readmitted will then be used.

All programs and courses listed in the ERAU catalog are not available at all campuses. For this reason, Articulations are often prepared for a specific campus. Students wishing to pursue an articulation at a campus other than the one specified by the Articulation should contact that campus to determine whether the desired program is available.

III. Admission/Transfer Requirements for Students. Students transferring to ERAU must be in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.0, and a combined GPA of 2.0 from all colleges/universities attended, in order to be considered for admission. A minimum grade of "C" is acceptable when the grade is equivalent to a 2.0 based on a 4.0 system.

ACT or SAT scores may be required by Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University for those students who have not earned college credit equivalent to the beginning courses in English and Mathematics required in the student's degree program.

It is important that the transfer student provide official transcripts as soon as possible for the timely evaluation and transfer of credits before actual enrollment in the University degree program. Students who decide to register before the formal transfer of credits is complete accept the risk of taking courses that are inappropriate and/or unnecessary for their degree program.

International students who are not permanent residents of the United States may be admitted with specific limitations and requirements in accordance with applicable laws.

IV. Selected Bachelor of Science Degree and Transfer Credit Information. For Bachelor of Science degree completion, at least 25 percent of semester credit hours must be earned through ERAU instruction. A minimum of thirty (30) semester hours toward the baccalaureate degree must be completed in residence with ERAU.

The grades used for the associate degree GPA will not be used when computing the GPA for the baccalaureate degree. To be eligible for honors, the student must have completed at least 45 credit hours in residence at ERAU and have a minimum 3.5 CGPA from courses completed with ERAU.

For a baccalaureate degree, a minimum of forty (40) semester hours in upper division (300 and 400 level) courses must be successfully completed.

Even though transfer credit is awarded for a specific ERAU course as part of this Agreement, no assumption may be made that credit is awarded for any prerequisite course(s) to the ERAU course unless it is (they are) specifically addressed as part of the Agreement. Additionally, Bergen Community College may not offer the specialized courses that are equivalent to those at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, so a full two (2) years of coursework may not transfer.

V. Miscellaneous. Any question or issues that surface and are not specifically addressed in this Agreement will be decided by applicable existing policies and procedures and by mutual agreement of the parties.

Either party may terminate the agreement by notifying the other in writing 90 days in advance of its intent to terminate such that no additional students will be admitted after the effective termination date and such that students already enrolled in either institution's program will have the opportunity to complete the program and receive the B.S. degree contemplated herein.

Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Inc. (ERAU) is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools' Commission on Colleges to award Bachelor, Masters, and Doctoral degrees. Bergen Community College is not accredited by the Commission on Colleges and the accreditation of ERAU does not extend to or include Bergen Community College or its students. Although ERAU accepts certain course work in transfer toward a credential from Bergen Community College, or collaborates in other ways for generation of course credits or program credentials, other colleges and universities may or may not accept this work in transfer, even if it appears on a transcript from ERAU. This decision is made by the institution subsequently considering the possibility of accepting such credits.
