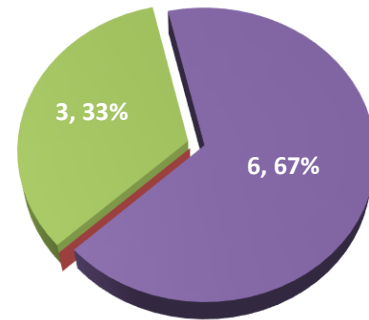

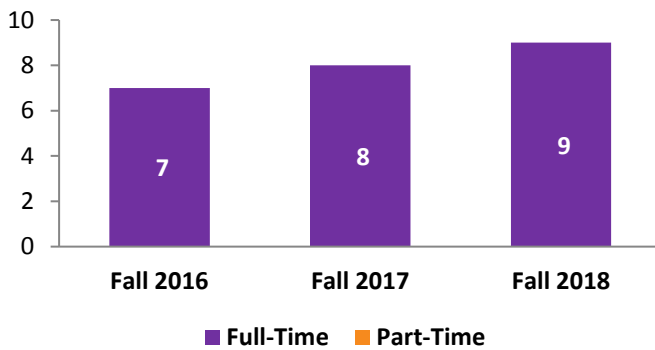

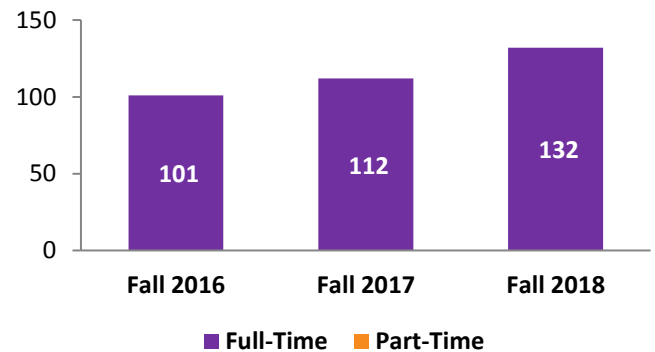

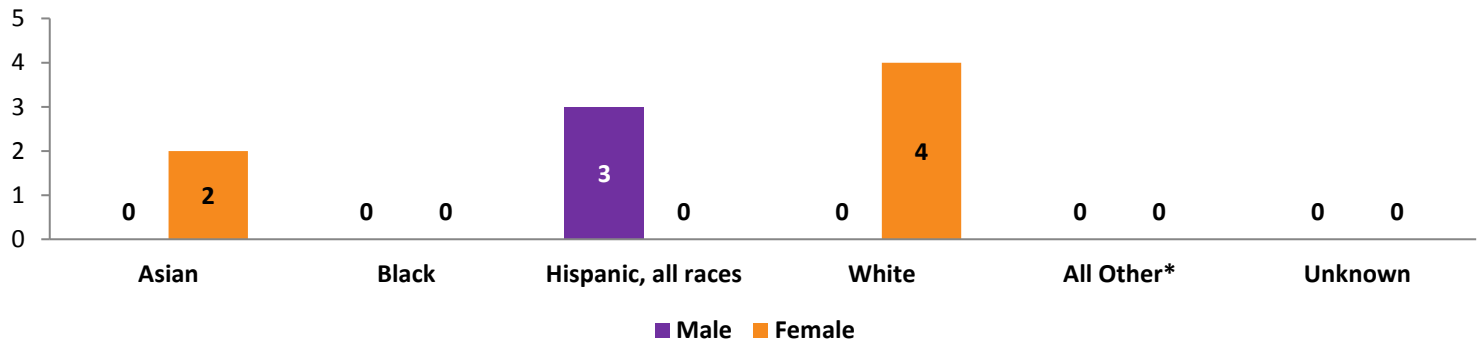

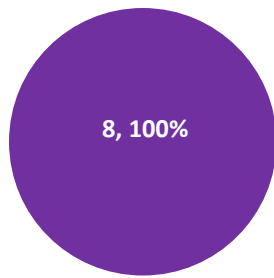
**Enrollment by Gender & Race/Ethnicity, Fall 2018**

**Fall-to-Spring Retention\*, Fall 2017**

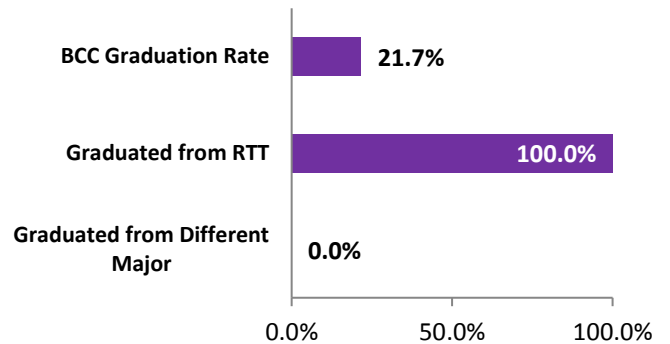


■ Retained after One Term ■ Not Retained after One Term

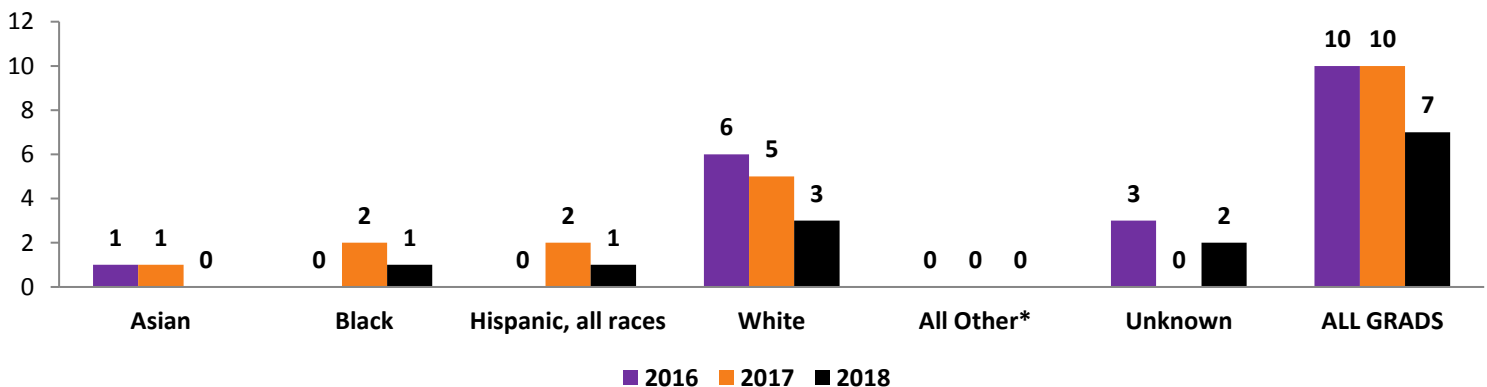
