- Continue to identify and implement strategies/actions when the expected levels of achievement for end-of-program student learning outcomes are not met.
- Ensure the program demonstrates that there are specific, measurable expected levels of achievement for each end-ofprogram student learning outcome.
- Ensure there are appropriate assessment methods that result in meaningful data for each end of program student learning outcome.
- Ensure there are sufficient data to inform program decision-making for each end-of-program student learning outcome.
- Review and revise the program completion outcome statement to be congruent with the ACEN definition of program completion including an appropriate ELA based on student demographics.
- Continue to identify and implement strategies/actions to improve the program completion rate when the expected level of achievement is not met.



Areas Needing Development (continued)

Standard 6 Outcomes, Criteria 6.1, 6.3, and 6.4

- Ensure a minimum of the three most recent years of available program completion data are aggregated for the nursing program as a whole.
- Ensure the assessment method(s) for job placement result in meaningful data from those contacted and make attempts to contact all graduates.
- Continue to identify and implement strategies/actions to improve the program's job placement rate when the expected level of achievement is not met.
- Ensure a minimum of the three most recent years of available job placement data are aggregated for the program as a whole.
