Collection services are needed to recover delinquent tuition and other miscellaneous fee payments.

The College evaluated eleven (11) proposals received in response to the RFP and determined that Allied Account Services Inc., General Revenue Corporation and Eastern Revenue Inc. have submitted comprehensive proposals that meet all of the requirements of the RFP. These companies have demonstrated experience and success with collection of past due student accounts in the community college sector, and offer competitive fees. The commission fees of the three selected companies are lower than the current rates and are as follows: Allied Accounts Services, Inc 14.5%, General Revenue Corporation 15% and Eastern Revenue, Inc 15%. The other eight companies were not selected due to limited experience with community colleges.

A Request for Proposals was advertised on the College website in accordance with New Jersey P.L. 2004 Chapter 19 "Pay to Play" Law, and conforms to a "Fair and Open Process".

This procurement is exempt from bidding in accordance with County College Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.5 (a) (14). (Student Collections)

This North New Jersey LSAMP Bridges to Baccalaureate Alliance Project Involves Bergen, Essex, Hudson, and Union community colleges with Passaic County Community College (PCCC) as lead agency. The purpose is to increase the associate degree graduation rate of underserved students and to facilitate barrier free transfer to baccalaureate study in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics. The annual budget is approximately \$68,035,50.

This proposed initiative furthers the 2021 – 2022 Presidential Goal # 1. Lead and support continuous improvement in the college-wide focus on student success, degree completion, college transfer and gainful employment. Focus on identifying the most at-risk student populations in order to close achievement gaps.

Submit a grant request of \$100,000 to the US Environmental Protection Agency for a proposal in collaboration with the NJ Composting Council, and authorize President Eric M. Friedman, Ph.D., or his designee, to execute required documents.

Justification

Building on expertise from pilot testing of Aerated Static Composting and related work, BCC and partner NJ Composting Council (NJCC) will introduce the technology to five community partners, including school districts, municipalities, community gardens, and or nonprofit environmental education groups. The grant will fund purchase, installation, and training to expand the use of composting. It will also provide educational curriculum modules and interactive lab investigations that introduce students to the science and engineering related to food waste recycling. Students will build skills in problem solving, data analysis, and experimental design. Participants will also learn about Bergen Community College STEM and environmental sciences resources and opportunities.

The project furthers the 2021 – 2022 Presidential Goal 9: Lead and support the development and implementation of initiatives related to increasing the College's visibility and improving outreach and storytelling to our communities.

The budget and project description are forthcoming. In-kind contributions will cover the 25% match, with contractual costs matched on a one-to-one basis by the subcontractor (NJCC) and BCC faculty time as a one-to-one cost match for work conducted during regular workday.
