SR 107-18/19 Course Addition HRM-2XXX Purchasing and Cost Control

The course has a 45% grading percentage for class participation. It was explained by faculty from HRM that this is because the class is very hands on and more like a lab.

There was a question about the math elective. A correction was made that MAT-280 is mandatory and an * was placed next to one of the footnotes.

All that needed to be changed was a typo to change MAT-288 to MAT 268. Doug Short noted that It was pulled because of a problem with how Datatel applies pre-requisite courses to the program, which could lead to financial aid being exhausted. There was nothing wrong with the curriculum and Datatel issues will need to be addressed by other than Senate.

SR 126-18/19

MAT-288 was corrected to MAT 268.

SR 127, 128, 130-18/19 60 CR Modification

There was discussion about options for these programs.

SR 146-18/19

The issue with this item was why it was being deleted if it has 49 students in it. Because no one was there from Business to speak to it, it was tabled until the March meeting. Victor Brown was going to be contacted about this.

TOPP Program

Brian Cordell reiterated the long standing policy that for a faculty member to teach online or hybrid courses they must complete the TOPP program. The main focus of the program is how to teach online and create/teach effective courses. Major problem is that Adjuncts do not take the TOPP program. It had started as an emergency program but when lecturers were let go, Brian and Amarjit made exceptions. However, now more and more are assigned online courses without TOPP. Discussion ensued.

A resolution was made: Distance Learning Resolution:

In order to uphold and preserve the consistency and quality of online/hybrid instruction, the College should reaffirm the current policy of requiring all faculty who will teach online/hybrid courses to complete the "TOPP for Teachers" or "TOPP Level 1" training before teaching an online or hybrid course at Bergen Community College.

Approved 30-2-5

Moodle Changes

Anthony Yankowski discussed the changes made to Moodle and most especially when the change was made. He noted that communication was inadequate; changes were made while faculty was still putting in grades from the Fall semester and teaching in Winter Session. He met with Amarjit Kaur and Patrick Simms and she said that it was her and Patrick who made the change as they needed tech support right before the holidays. Anthony reiterated that faculty was not consulted before the switch was thrown and it made for more work for teaching faculty and more frustration for the students.

A resolution was made:

The Senate shall compose a sub-committee specifically tasked with coordinating updates/revisions to the school's learning management system with CITL or its designee.
