Graduate Characteristics Highlights

- The number of female graduates eclipsed the number of male graduates in every age group.
- Hispanic students accounted for 30% of graduates who reported their ethnicity.
- White students accounted for 68% of all Non-Hispanic graduates.
- For every 5 graduates in 2013, 4 of them were from Bergen County.
- More than 66% of graduates had a GPA higher than 3.00.

Degrees Awarded Highlights

- Degrees awarded in Transfer Programs outnumbered those awarded in Career Programs 4 to 1.
- The number of degrees awarded in A.S. Professional Studies was more than 4 times
 higher than those awarded in A.A. Liberal Arts,
 the next most popular program.
- 46.8% of all degrees awarded were done so in May 2013.
- Associate in Arts, Associate in Applied Science and Certificate Programs continued declining trends while Associate in Science saw another sharp increase in degrees awarded from 2012 to 2013.


