

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Hispanic students made up 24.8% of the 2016 graduating class.
- Over 78% of 2016 graduates were from Bergen County.
- For counties outside of Bergen, Passaic had the most graduates with 162 (6.7%).



#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Seventy-one percent of graduates in 2016 graduated with a GPA of 3.00 or higher.
- Females made up 54% of the 2016 graduating class.
- Eighty percent of the graduates were between the ages of 20 and 29.

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Over 80% of the degrees/certificates awarded in 2016 were from Transfer Programs.
- The ten most popular majors accounted for over 70% of the degrees/certificates awarded in 2016.
- Nearly 38% of degrees/certificates awarded in 2016 were AS.PS.GEN degrees.
- May was the most popular commencement date in 2016 with over a thousand awards handed out (48.1%).
- Associate of Science (AS) degrees continued a 10-year trend of being the most popular type of degree/certificate awarded.
