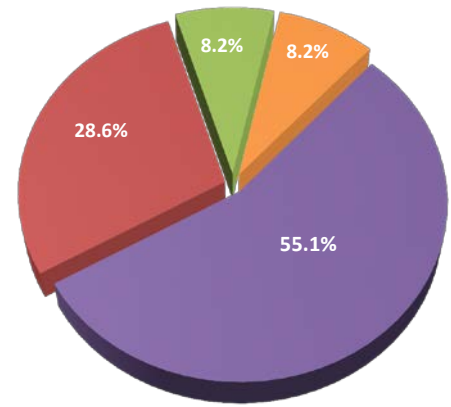

Fall 2012

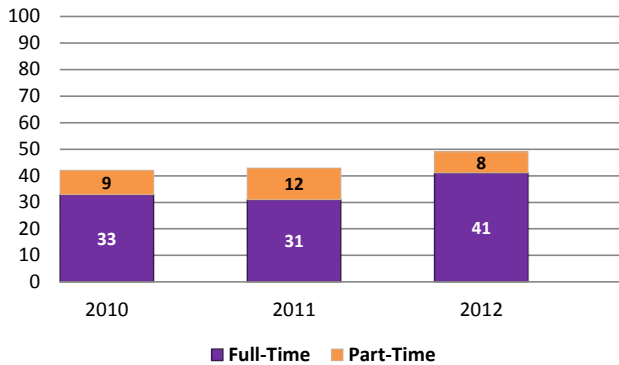

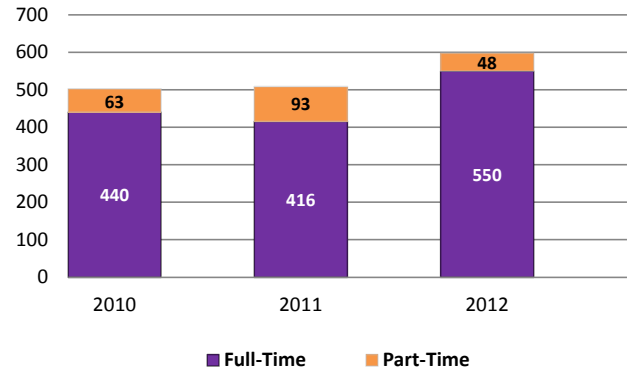

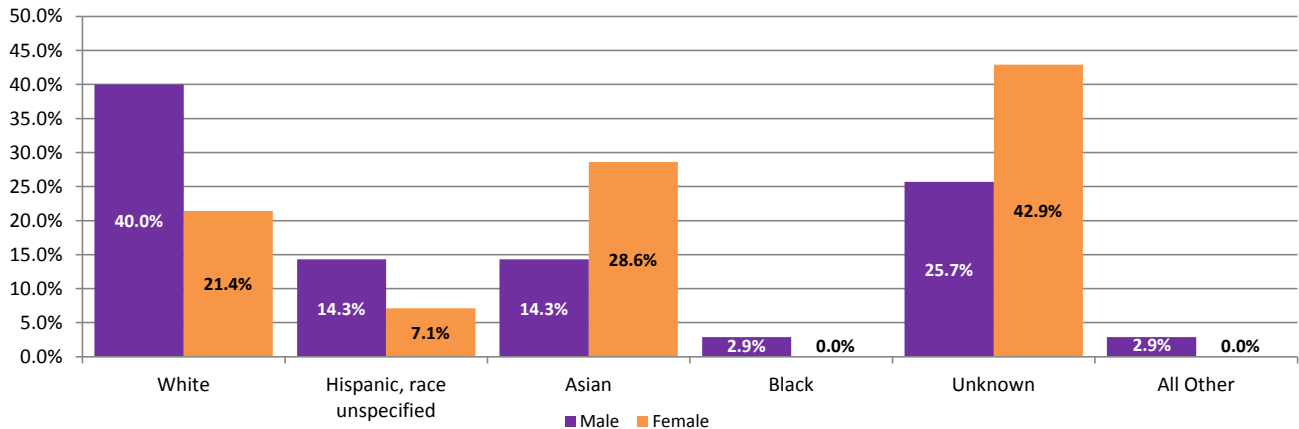

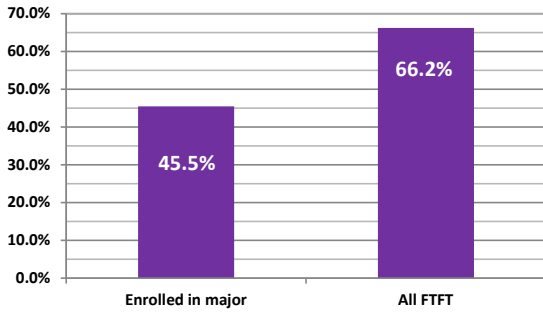

**One-Year Retention\*, FTFT, Fall 2011**



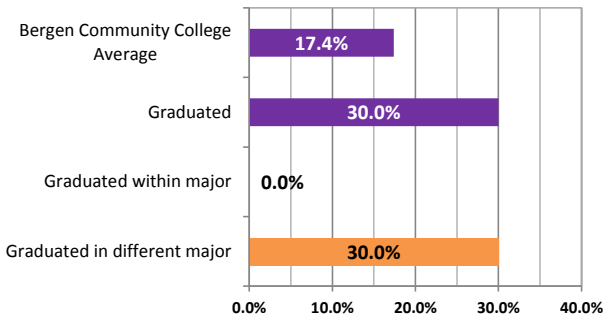

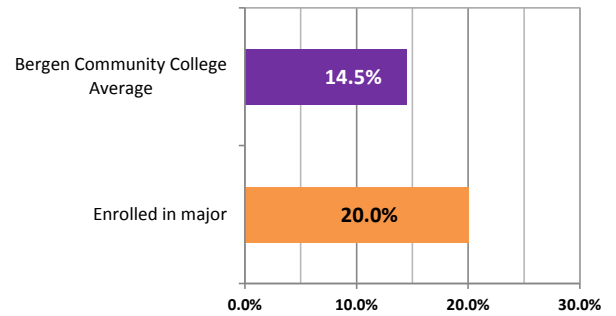

**Graduation Rates\*, 2009 Cohort**



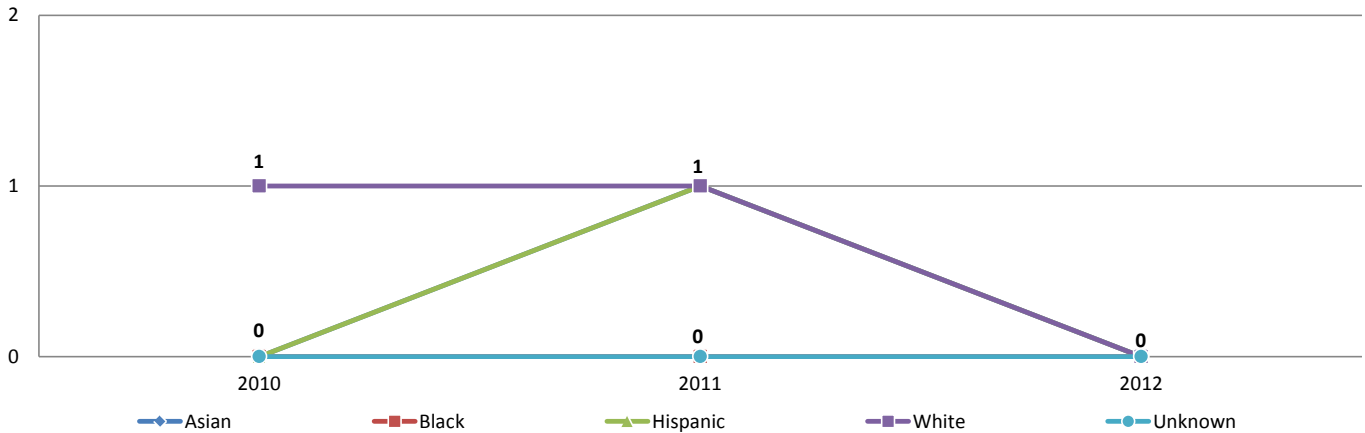
