





Percent Change in Job Growth, NYC Metropolitan Region




Chart shows the combined job growth for the following target occupations:* Medical Assistants, Medical Equipment Preparers


**Job growth for target occupations regardless of educational attainment




Degrees Awarded* by Race/Ethnicity
