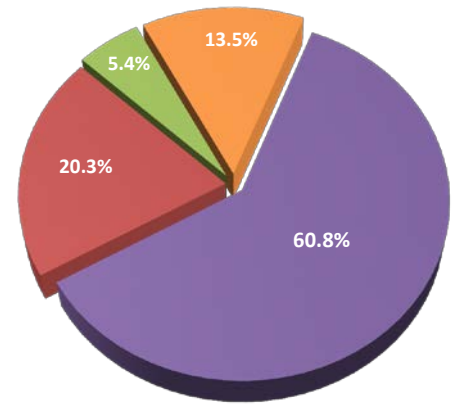

Fall 2012

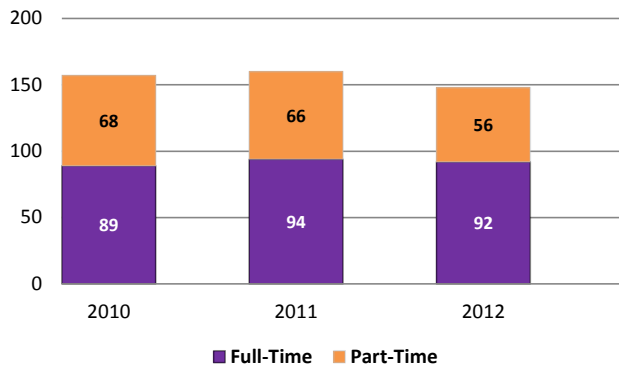

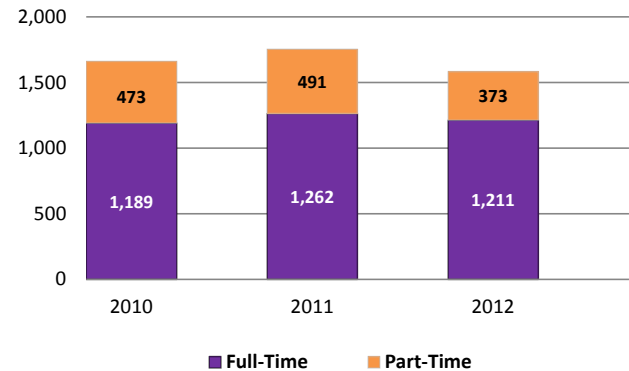

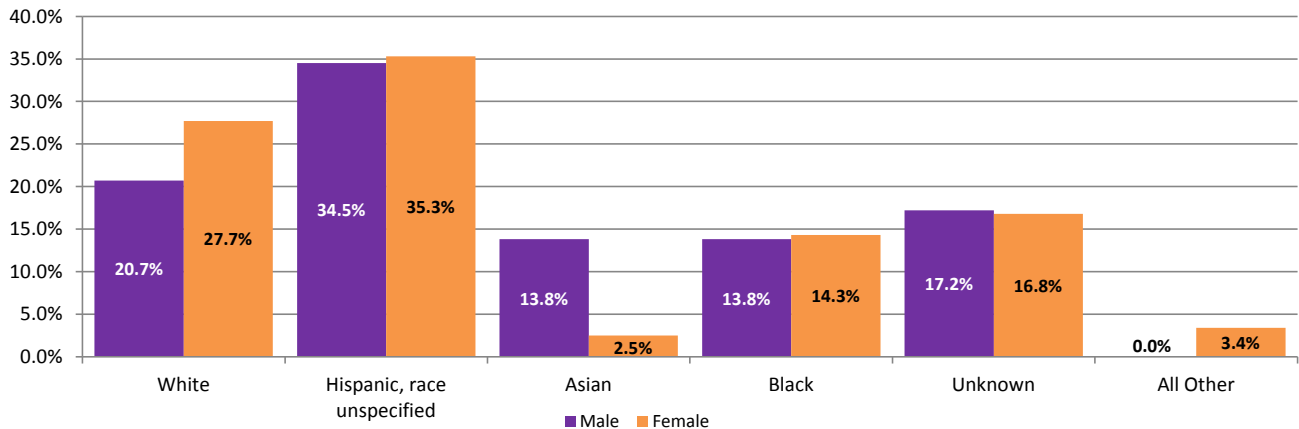

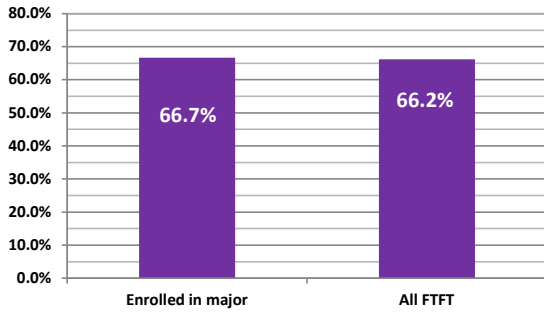

**Transfer Colleges\*, 2009 Cohort**

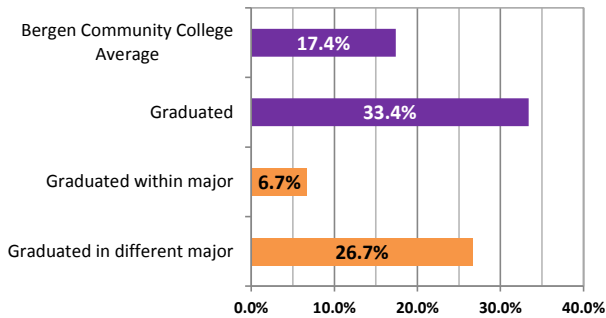

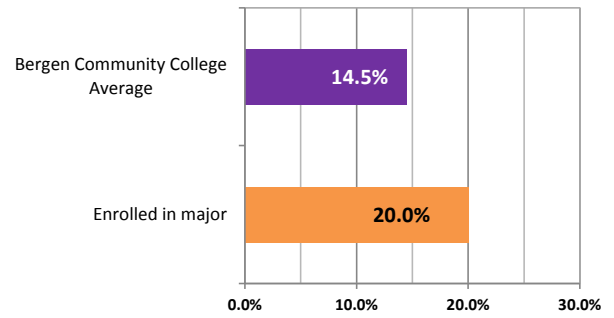

**Graduation Rates\*, 2009 Cohort**



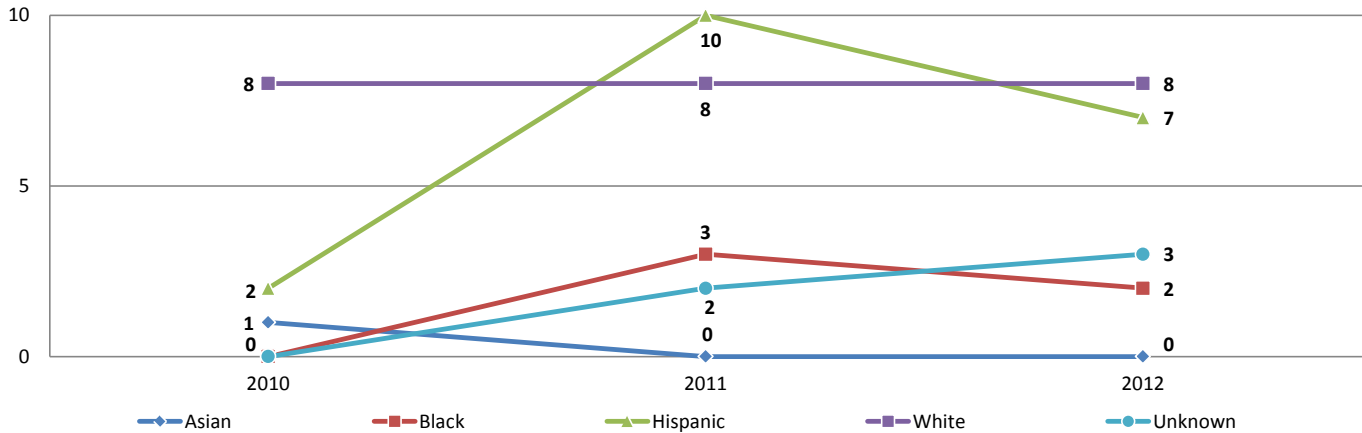
**Transfer Rates\*, 2009 Cohort**
