


SPRING ENROLLMENT TRENDS 2008 – 2017

The following presents the ten-year trend analyses of spring enrollments at Bergen Community College. Specifically, these analyses consist of student headcount and credit totals for spring 2008 to spring 2017. The trends presented are based on enrollment data generated at the end of the 10th Day for each semester.






