Headcount and Credits Generated

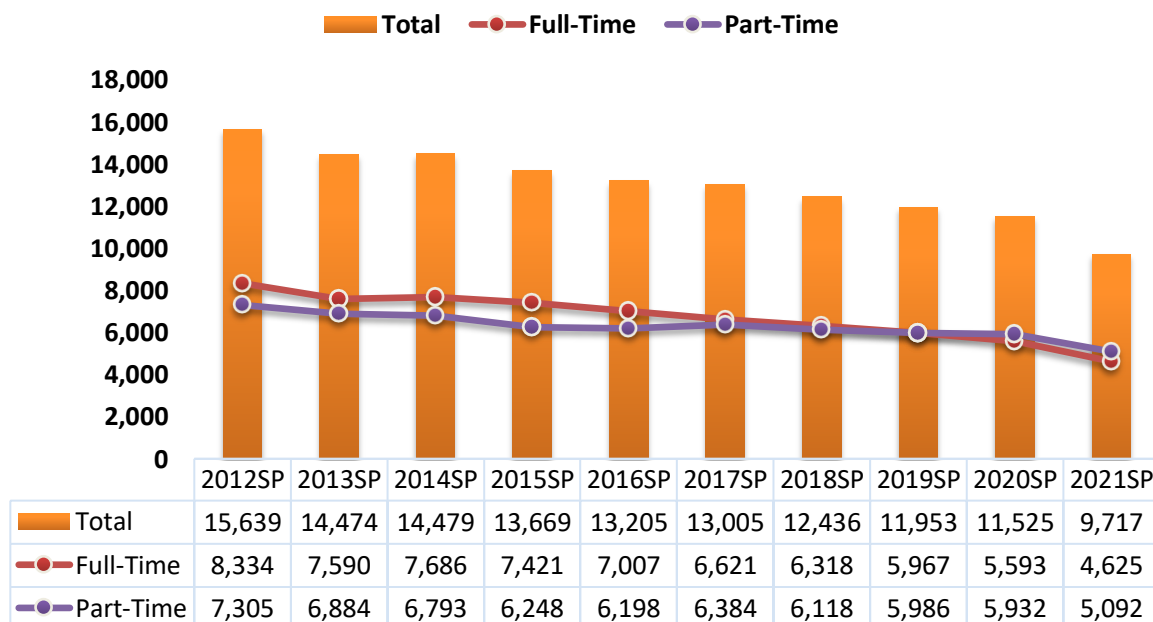

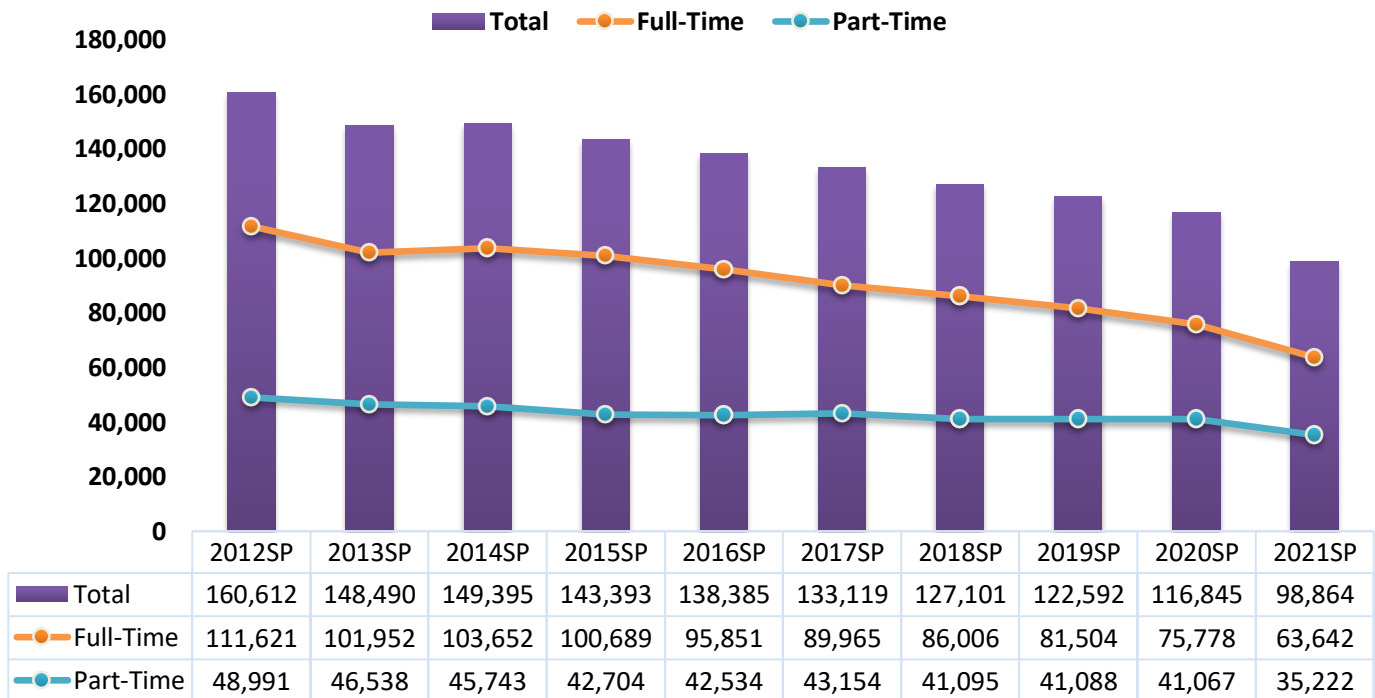

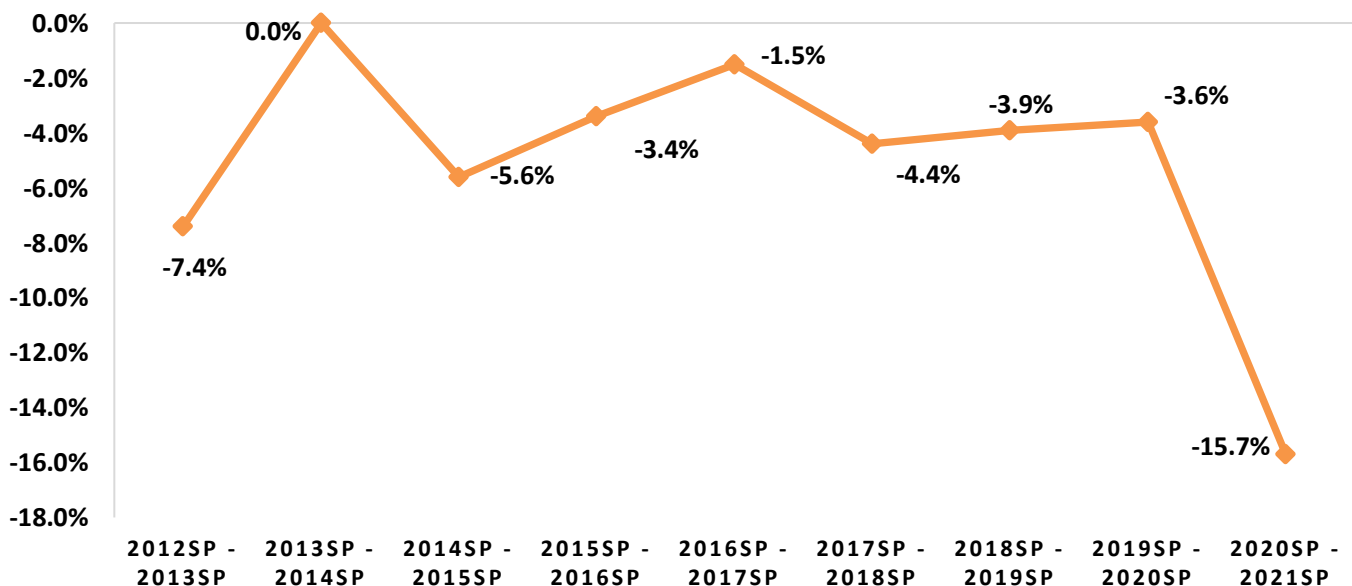
Semester to Semester Changes

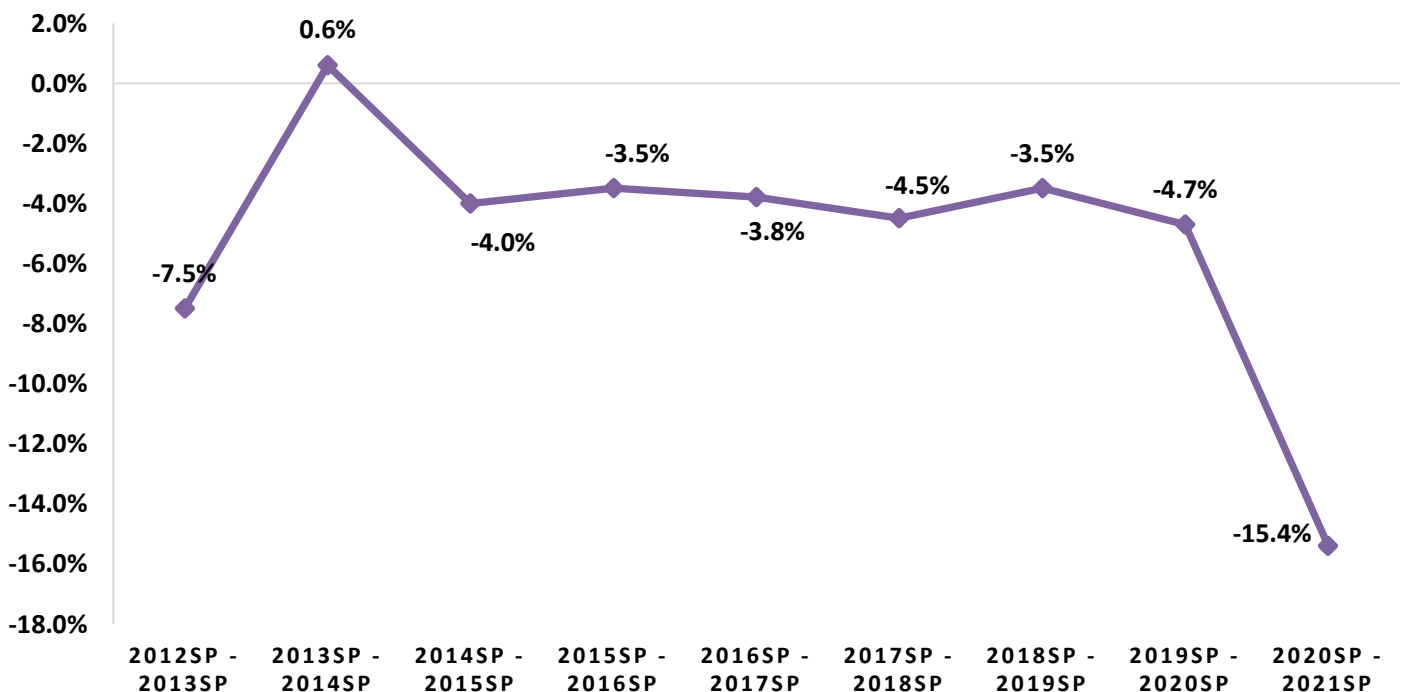
