



INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY for BCC Students:

Clinical Oncology Open Learning (COOL) Scholars 2022 Application Information for Students

Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (MSK), New York, NY

DESCRIPTION: COOL is a 6-week summer program led by Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center (MSK) to encourage undergraduates from a variety of backgrounds to consider careers in oncology. Each student is assigned to one of our seven regional network sites in Long Island, New Jersey, or Westchester. The student engages in clinical observation and learning in oncology, including 1-o-1 teaching, conferences, and educational seminars.

ELIGIBILITY: The program is open to students enrolled in a degree program at BCC.

MSK encourages applications from groups currently underrepresented in oncology research, including students who are women, Native American, Black, Latinx, Veteran and students with disabilities.

Application deadline Monday, January 24, 2022 at 5:00 pm EST.

Program Dates: Monday, June 13, 2022 to Friday, July 22, 2022 (6 weeks, full-time).

MENTORS: Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center Regional Network Faculty

This is a paid internship: All COOL participants will be paid a stipend for the 6-week program. Housing and transportation are NOT provided; they are the responsibility of the student.
