Moodlerooms successfully completed server upgrade to version 3.4. As a result of this upgrade you will find some changes to the current Moodle features and functionality.

So, what can you expect after the upgrade.

1. **Calendar Management:** Events created manually may be dragged and dropped to different dates. Watch video tutorial on [how to add/edit or delete an event](#).
2. **Private file Storage Space:** The storage space used in private files area is visible to users. The default storage space is set to 100MB. Watch video tutorial on [how to easily check your private files storage space](#).
3. **Activity Navigation:** Users can navigate course activities using the links to the Next or Previous activity. Watch a [video tutorial](#) on this topic.
4. **Mobile App:** Link to the Moodle Mobile app is available from the user profile. Watch video tutorial on how to [download the mobile app](#).
5. **User Management:** Using the participant link from the navigation block, course instructor can filter users by the inactive period, enrollment method and role. Watch [how to filter users](#).
6. **Activity Completion Status:** Course instructors can manually mark activities which are completed manually or did not get marked completed automatically. Watch [how to mark activities completed on behalf of students](#).
7. **List of File Types:** Course instructors can now see a list of suggested file types when specifying accepted files. Watch [how to select file types](#).
