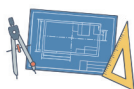

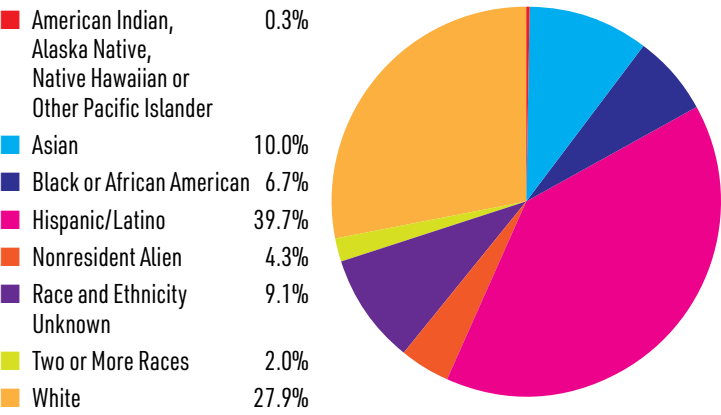

Top Five Municipalities of Degree/ Certificate Students

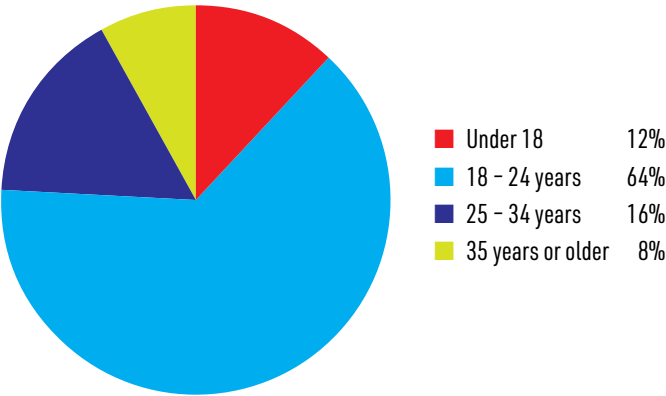

Top Five Non-General/ Professional Studies Degree Programs

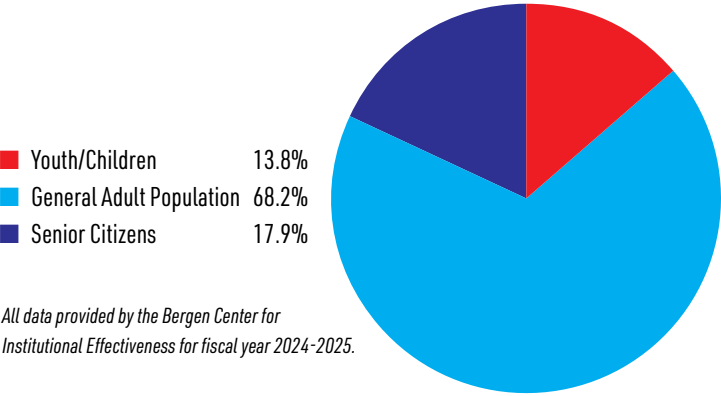
