

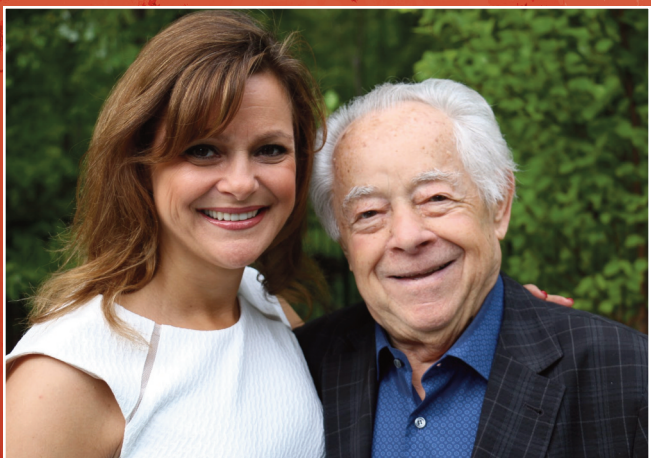

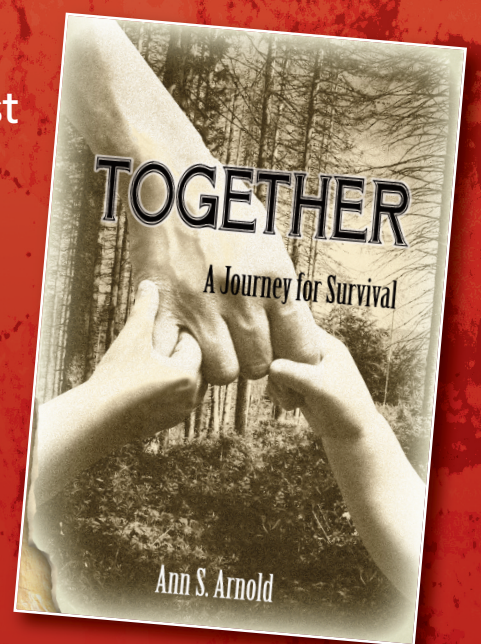

portrays the strength of a mother's love and the incredible courage of good people during the worst of times. Ann earned the Simon Wiesenthal Center's Heroes for Tolerance award for her work and lectures on tolerance.
